## Constituency Session Rules

Approved and Recommended by the Southern California Conference Executive Committee

- 1. Any delegate addressing the meeting from a microphone must first state their name and the entity they represent or their delegate-at-large status.
- 2. Points of order/information and privileged motions will be handled at a separate microphone designated for such a purpose.
- 3. A delegate will not speak to a motion more than twice, and will only speak a second time after all others wishing to speak have done so.
- 4. There will be a time limit of two minutes for speeches from the floor; three minutes if the speech is being translated.
