# Allocation of Members to Serve on the Nominating Committee 

## Bylaws Requirement

3.2.1 Composition. The nominating committee shall consist of twenty-one (21) members, including the president of the Pacific Union Conference or his/her appointee, who shall chair this committee. The membership of this committee shall, as nearly as possible, proportionately represent the membership of this conference, properly recognizing gender, ethnic and geographical backgrounds. No more than twentyfive percent (25\%) of those who were members of the preceding nominating committee may serve on this committee. Incumbent officers, departmental directors, associate directors and assistant directors shall not be members of this committee. No more than twenty-five percent (25\%) of the members of the nominating committee may serve on the executive committee; conversely, no more than twenty-five percent (25\%) of the non-administrative members of the executive committee may serve on the nominating committee.
